

## Information about the coronavirus

The new coronavirus is raising many concerns among the public. According to the Public Health Agency of Sweden, the risk of discovering cases of coronavirus (covid-19) infection in Sweden is high, but the risk of widespread infection is deemed to be low.

Älvkarleby municipality is monitoring events as they develop, remains in contact with the relevant authorities and follows their recommendations.

If you have general questions about corona, how the authorities are handling the situation, or if you feel concern, call 113 13.

If you have been abroad in the past 14 days and have a fever or respiratory symptoms such as coughing, laboured breathing, or a sore throat, do not go to a health centre or hospital directly.
